### Scroll multiple fields

Use the bar to scroll along the many different fields.

### Try yourself

If you wished to find out the number of advertisements for runaway females that were originally from the Africa, you would write "Female" in the **Gender** column search, and then add "Africa" in the **Origin**. Then you could click the arrow at the top of the **Date** field, to organise the advertisements in ascending chronological order.

### Column search

Search multiple individual fields, which is useful if you want to narrow down data for specific categories. For example, to show all female runaways, you would type "female" into the "**Gender**" column and only those advertisements that contained a female runaway would be displayed.
